Tour Overview



인천 가오슝
Day1 Incheon - Kaohsiung

Arrive in Kaohsiung and start your first night in Taiwan. Experience Taiwanese cuisine in the exotic atmosphere of the port city, slowly beginning your journey.

가오슝 타이둥
Day2 Kaohsiung - Taidong

Heading southernmost along Taiwan's west coast, you cross the hills of Kending and the Wind, known as the 'Hawaii of Taiwan.' Running along the coast and villages, with the Taiwan Strait bordering China.

타이둥 화롄
Day3 Taidong - Hoa-liân

Drive along Coastal Road 11, which runs along the Pacific Ocean, passing through cliff coasts. Passing Sanxiandai and Xitingping Coastal Rock, taste Taitung's specialty fruit Shiguo and stroll through Hualien town.

Day4 화련 일월담 Hoa-liân - Rìyuè tán

Cross Taroger Gorge and the Heohwansan alpine road at 3,275m elevation, and arrive at Sun Moon Dam, a mountain lake at 800m above sea level. The most beloved vacation spot among Taiwanese people.

Day5 일월담 자이현 Rìyuè tán - Chiayi

After trekking through the Oksan section, stay at the high-altitude tea village at 2,000 meters above sea level. Stay in the heart of oolong tea and enjoy a special night where you can fully experience the aroma and flavor of tea in the fresh air and nature.

Day6 자이현 인천 Chiayi - Incheon

Riders ride south along Route 3, which is the most popular choice for riders. Driving along the Taiwan Long-Winding National Highway, you complete your final journey where you can fully experience the fun and rhythm of riding.

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Paradise for Two Wheels

At every intersection, there are dedicated waiting lines for scooters, making the sight of traveling on two wheels a natural part of daily life. These environments are relatively open to travelers as well, allowing scooters to be used under an international driving permit. Through this, travelers can ride through the city's alleys and coastal roads, experiencing the well-equipped motorcycle infrastructure firsthand and encountering Taiwan's streets and daily life up close.



Taiwan is built for life on two wheels. Scooter lanes, rider zones, and dense infrastructure shape the rhythm of its streets, allowing travelers to explore coastal roads and hidden alleys with rare freedom and local immersion.

From Sea to the High Mountains

Taiwan is one of the world's most renowned countries for its alpine terrain. Within the small island, there are over 260 mountains over 3,000 meters above sea level, with the highest peak, Mount Wi, reaching 3,952 meters. About 70% of the island's area is mountainous, making it a place with very distinct changes in terrain.



Taiwan is a land of dramatic elevation, where coastal roads rise into cloud-level mountain passes. Tropical forests, deep gorges, and alpine landscapes unfold within a single island, creating one of Asia's most dynamic riding experiences.

Taiwanese tables are a unique food culture created by the natural blend of deep Chinese flavors and Japanese delicacy. Thanks to the warm and humid climate, the fruit is exceptionally sweet and fragrant; on the roads, you can taste crisp wax jambu, and in Taitung, you can taste stone fruits said to resemble Buddha's head. 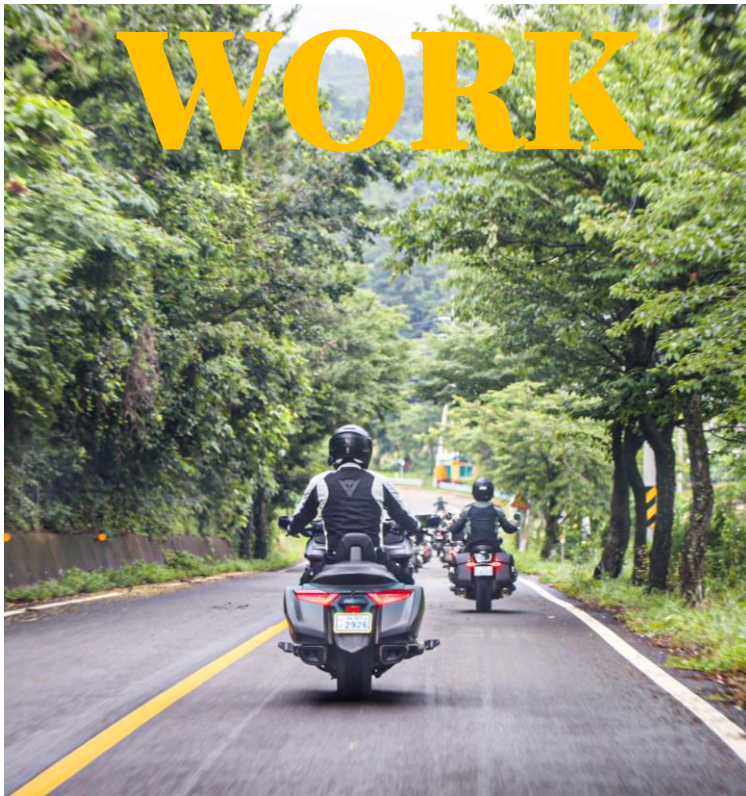
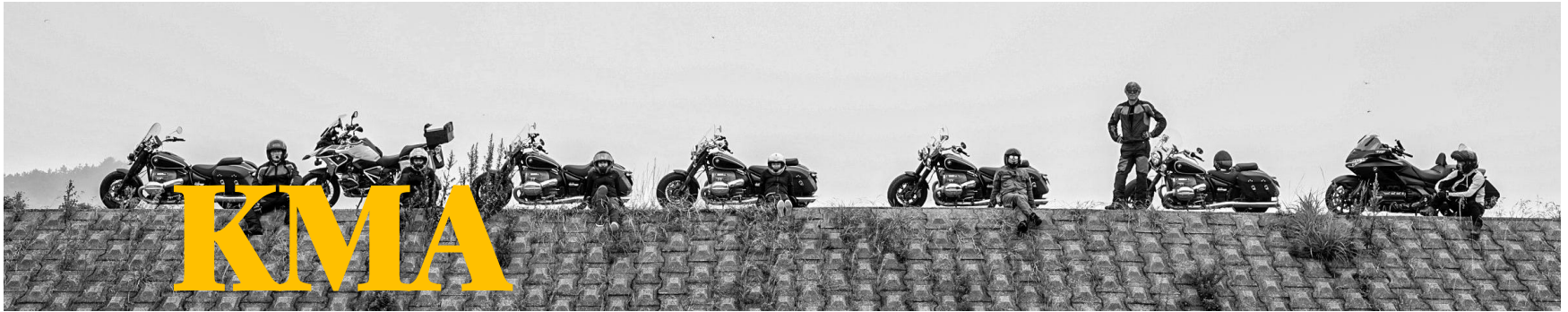


Accommodation
