The Pamir Highway is one of the most beautiful and challenging adventure riding routes in the world.

The approximately 2,600 km route connecting Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan crosses the Akbaital Pass at 4,655 meters above sea level, continuing along the Tianshan and Pamir Mountains, the Wakan Corridor, and the Afghan border region.

Driving along endless grasslands and alpine lakes, vast gorges and desolate plateaus, and thousands of years of Silk Road history along these roads, you'll experience a ride you'll never forget.

Safely complete the world's best adventure riding courses, challenging yourself to push beyond nature, history, and your own limits.

Day0 인천공항 비슈케크 Incheon - Bishkek

Departing from Incheon International Airport, it will transit through Almaty, Kazakhstan, and arrive in Bishkek, the capital of Kyrgyzstan.

Day1 비슈케크 Bishkek

Relieve the fatigue accumulated from the long journey and prepare for the main ride that will begin the next day. In the evening, all participants gather to share the tour schedule and safety guidelines.

Day2 비슈케크 이식쿨 Bishkek – Issyk-Kul

Beyond Bishkek, the ridges and grasslands of the Tianshan Mountains unfold. Depending on the route, you can visit gorges and viewpoints leading to Burana Tower near Tokmok or Lake Issyk-Kul.

Day3 이식쿨 송쿨 Isikul–Songkul

Leaving Lake Iszkul bathed in morning sunlight, we head toward the highlands of inland Kyrgyzstan. Passing through lakeside roads and grasslands, you enter a mountain road that gradually increases in elevation.



Day4 송쿨 잘랄아바드 Songkul–Jalal-Abad

This section features many changes, including alpine meadows, unpaved mountain roads, and valley trails. The view of Songkul Lake from the high pass and the winding mountain roads are the main shooting spots for the day.



Day5 잘랄아바드 레닌봉 Jalal-Abad–Lenin Peak

Entering the mountain road leading to the Pamir Plateau, the surrounding landscape rapidly shifts from urban and farmland to vast mountain range.

Day6 사리타시 무르갭 Saritasi–Murgab

This is the day the main Pamir Highway section of the tour begins. It transforms from a green meadow into a desolate and vast alpine desert.

Day7 무르갭 와칸 회랑 Murghab–Wakhan Corridor

Unpaved sections leading into Yashikul Lake may be included, so it is necessary to check the road surface conditions and waterway passage in advance. Yashikul is a prime photo spot where Pamir's desolate mountainous terrain contrasts with its blue lakes.

Day8 와칸 회랑 호루그 Wakan Corridor – Horog

This is one of the most historically and scenic sections of the Pamir tour. Driving along the road along the Panji River, you can see villages in Afghanistan across the river and the Hindu Kush Mountains.

Day9 호루그 칼라이쿰 Horug–Kalaikum

A narrow road stretches long between the river and cliffs, and across the street, you can see mountain villages and roads in Afghanistan.



Day10 칼라이쿰 두산베 Kalai Kum–Dushanbe

Depending on the road conditions on the day, you can choose a safe section in the southern Kulob direction or the northern mountain road. Before departure, the local guide and driving team must check the road controls, construction, and rockfall conditions.



Day11 두산베 알마티 Dushanbe–Almaty

Dushanbe is the political and cultural center of Tajikistan, showcasing a modern urban landscape completely different from the Pamir region.

Day12 알마티 인천 Almaty-Incheon

Board your flight to Incheon from Almaty International Airport. After 11 nights and 12 days of frontier riding in Kyrgyzstan and Tajikistan, we return to South Korea.

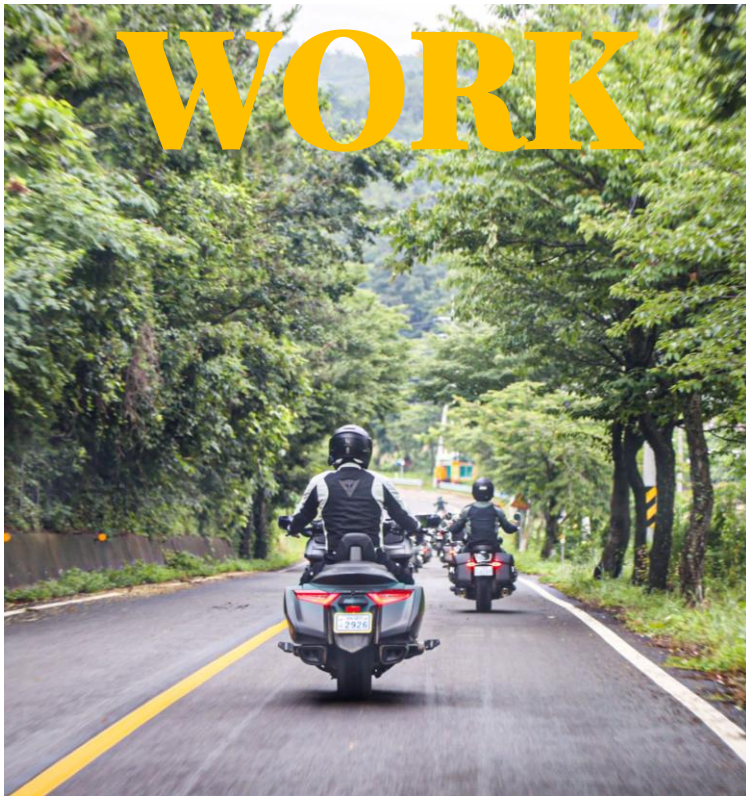
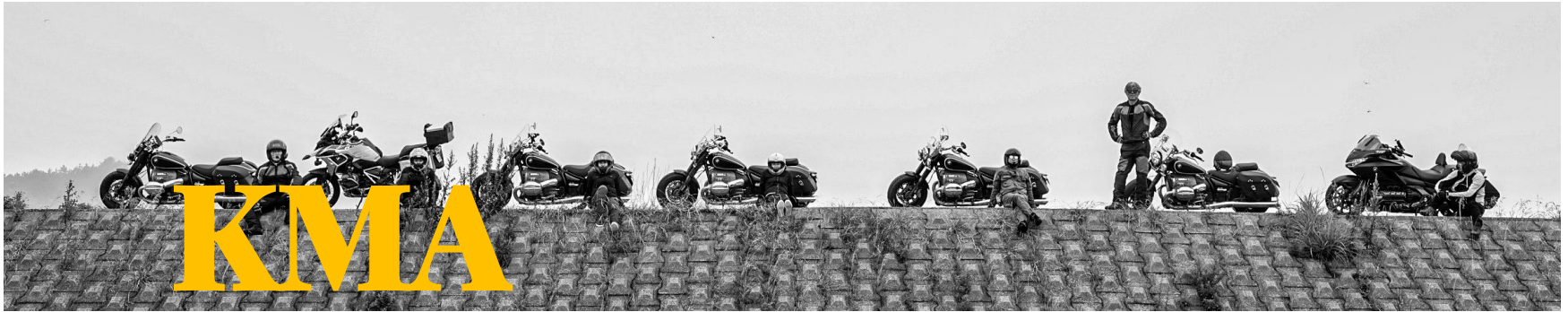
Food Culture
